







God sent to Abram a vision of a burning torch. What did God say to Abram then?

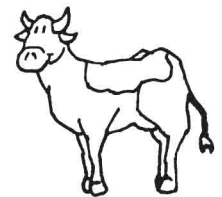
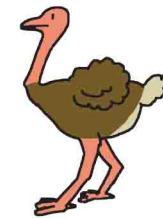
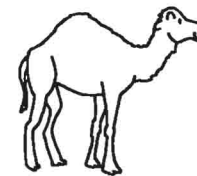
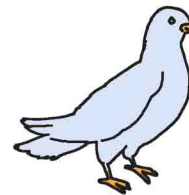


God told Abram to bring five specific animals.
