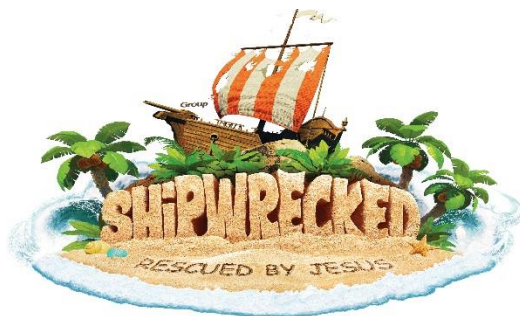
Please pray for our church as we move forward with the next step of the re-branding process.

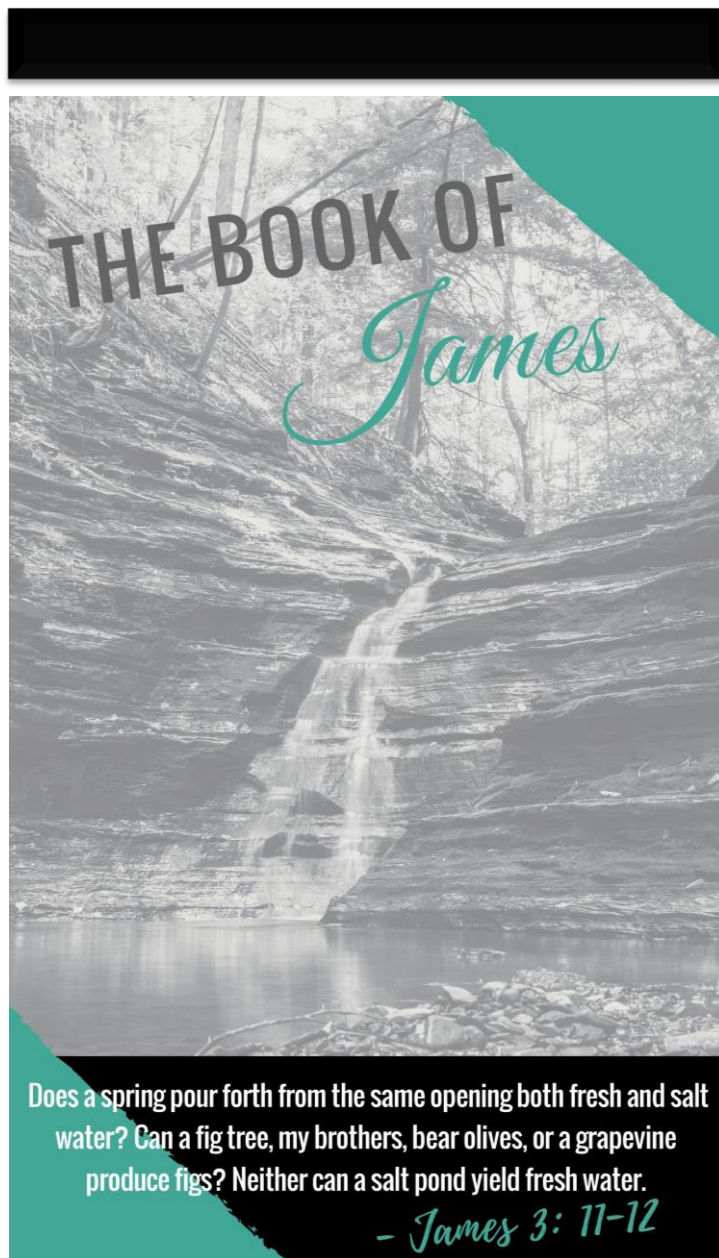

USMB News from Don Morris & Randy Friesen

Our USMB family and our global MB family have been envisioning how we can better serve together on One Mission: local, national and global. As USMB, we have invited MB Mission as our global mission agency to come alongside us in new ways to serve our collective focus on discipleship, leadership development and church planting. As we have worked on that together, MB Mission has also been on a journey to bring church planting supports like the C2C Network to the US to increase our capacity to call out, discern and support church planters.

In March, the MB Mission board affirmed a strategic plan to merge our two organizations – MB Mission and C2C Network – into one new entity. The strategic planning discernment process included representatives from the US and Canadian MB conferences, ICOMB and our global MB Mission leaders. The new strategic plan calls for multiplying healthy disciples, churches and harvest partnerships. The new overarching name that the Board approved for this local, national and global mission network is *Multiply*.
