*We desire as a church to take hold of the vision God has for us and pray that He would lead and guide us to take a collective step of faith, in the direction that He would have us go.*

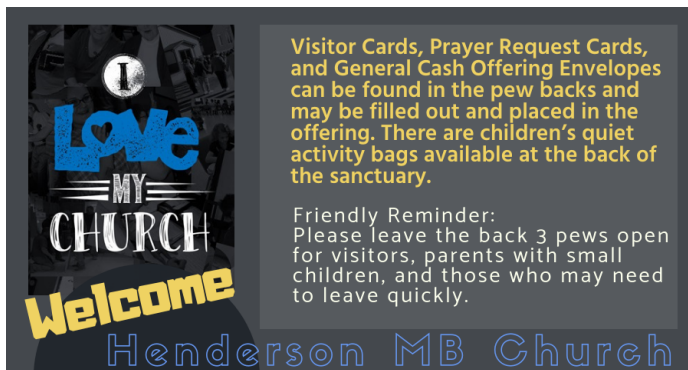
*Pray that we, as a church, grasp the church vision that He has for us, and may we be sensitive to His leading and guidance.*

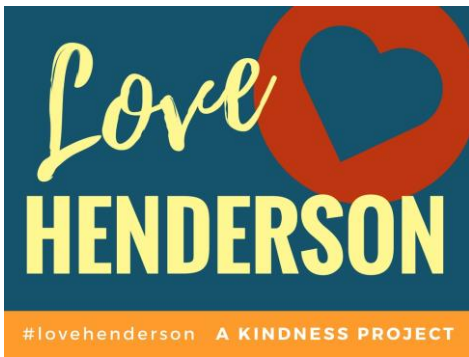
