Proposed Amendment to the Church Constitution The following proposed change in the Constitution clarifies how to handle partial terms served on the board as it relates to term limitations and will be voted on at the annual business meeting.

Section 7.2 - Leadership Board (also referred to as the Board) 7.2.1 Composition and Terms of the Board - The Leadership Board shall consist of the Pastor, the Treasurer, and five members who are elected at-large from the active members of the congregation. The term of service for the Treasurer and the five at-large members shall be three years. Except for the Pastor, who is a continuing member of the Board, a Board member may serve two consecutive terms but must be off of the Board for at least one year before serving an additional term. If a Board member serves a partial term that is less than half of a full term, that partial term shall not be counted as part of the consecutive **term limitation.** To be eligible for the Leadership Board a nominee must be an active member and have 2 years of regular attendance. Nominees shall exhibit character in alignment with expectations outlined in the New Testament for those in church leadership.
