

Kickball Rules

- Each game shall consist of 6 innings or 45 minutes.
- Each kicker shall receive only one rolled ball unless deemed un-kickable by the umpire. In this case, another ball will be rolled.
- An out shall be recorded as a normal baseball or softball game records outs ... plus an out shall be recorded when a kicker kicks 3 foul balls during one at bat.
- 'Pegging' or throwing the ball at a runner is allowed if runner is hit between shoulders and knees. If runner is hit above shoulders or below knee, runner is deemed safe.
- No bunting allowed.
- No minimum of males or females playing are required.
- No stealing is allowed.
- Players may be rotated in the field but only 7 players in the field are allowed.
- All players on roster (maximum of 10) must kick in consecutive order.
- The game shall be called 'over' when one team is ahead by 10 or more runs after 4 or more innings and so on.
- If a game is tied after 6 innings or after 45 minutes is completed, the game will continue until there is a winner at the end of a completed inning.
- No profanity

- All calls by field umpire are final
- Christ-like sportsmanship is expected.
- Coin flip at the beginning of game determines possession.
- The game must start and finish with a minimum of 7 players.
- Only registered players will be allowed to play in the tournament unless otherwise allowed by tournament director.
- Once a team is eliminated from the tournament, no player from that team may play for another team.
