

2019 St. Peter's Art Show Jury Process/Sample Submission Requirements

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

JURY PROCESS REVIEW ~

Three (3) digital images of work are required for:

- 2-dimensional artists applying for the **first time** in 2019 to the art show.

Three (3) digital images of work with written explanation are *subject to the jurying process* and required for:

- 3-dimensional fine crafters and photographers who are ***new in 2019***; and,
- 3-dimensional fine crafters and photographers who need to satisfy the two-consecutive year jury process, i.e., 2017 & 2018.

Letters of acceptance or non-acceptance to participate in the St. Peter's Art Show will be mailed to all juried applicants during the month of April.

DIGITAL SAMPLE REQUIREMENTS ~

The three (3) quality digital images representative of your work must be submitted to artshow@stpeterslewes.org. Each digital sample must represent only a single image; no groupings. The peer jury will evaluate each image based on quality/craftsmanship and originality. A short description of each image is encouraged, describing your technique, materials used, originality, inspiration, etc. for the jury review. You will be contacted if the committee needs more information.

Note: 2-dimensional artists who participated in 2018 and 3-dimensional fine crafters and photographers who participated in consecutive years (2017 and 2018) are exempted from submitting samples and the jury process.
