

2025 St. Peter's Art Show Jury Process/Sample Submission Requirements

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

JURY PROCESS REVIEW

Artists who have never been in the show must be juried for two consecutive shows. After being juried and accepted for two consecutive shows artists are no longer required to be juried unless they significantly change the medium and or style of their work. Artists who do significantly change their medium and or style will be required to be juried for two additional consecutive shows. Artists who have been juried successfully for two consecutive shows but do not participate in the prior year's show (2024) may be required to go through the jury process again.

Artists applying for the first time or second consecutive time (participated in 2024 show) in 2025 or are otherwise required to be juried as described above must submit the following on or before March 15, 2025:

- Three (3) digital images of the artist's work
- Each image shall be of a different example of the artist's work
- Each image shall be accompanied by a brief description

Letters of acceptance or non-acceptance to participate in the St. Peter's Art Show will be emailed to all juried applicants during the month of April.

DIGITAL SAMPLE REQUIREMENTS

The three (3) quality digital images representative of your work must be submitted to artshow@stpeterslewes.org at the time you submit your application. Each digital sample must represent only a single image; no groupings. The jury will evaluate each image based on quality/craftsmanship and originality. A short description of each image is required, describing your technique, materials used, originality, inspiration, etc. for the jury review. You will be contacted if the committee needs more information.
