4. Use an online Bible tool like www.biblegateway.com or the cross references in your Bible or ask someone about other places in the Bible where we are urged to seek God with our whole heart. What do these passages have in common?

5. Psalm 119:8 says, "I will keep your statutes; do not utterly forsake me." We know that no one keeps the word of God perfectly. In what ways did Jesus fulfill this verse for us?

6. What steps have you taken in the past to know more of God's word? What steps are you taking right now to know more of God's word?

7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:7. Discuss what you can learn to better praise God and serve him.
