1. Have you ever been at the end of your rope when all you had to hope in was God's word? How did the Word sustain you?
2. Read Psalm 13. How might this Psalm have influenced the young man who wrote Psalm 119?
3. The writer of this Psalm speaks of himself as a sojourner (traveler) on earth. How are we too travelers in search of our home? How should this affect the way we live as Christians?
4. How does God rebuke us? How should we respond to God's rebuke.
5. In verse 23 we learn that leaders are plotting against the psalmist. How does he respond? How should we respond to trials and temptations?
6. Psalm 119:24 says that the testimonies of God are the delight and counselors of the writer. How does God's word bring you delight? How does it counsel you?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:18. Talk together about how this verse can change the way you study the Bible?
