LifeGroup Discussion

Date: February 5, 2017

Psalm 119:33-40

1. What does the psalmist ask the Lord to do in this passage? How does God do these things in our lives today?
2. Does your understanding of your own sinfulness and great spiritual needs help you to treasure Christ more? How? How does this understanding also affect your relationship with others?
3. What should we do when our “whole heart” doesn’t want to observe God’s Word (v. 34)? What are some ways that the Lord “inclines” our hearts to his Word (v.35)?
4. What are some of the “worthless things” that distract us (v. 37)? How can we turn from these things and find life in God’s ways?
5. What does it look like for us to seek understanding and teaching from God? What does this look like individually? As a LifeGroup? As a church family?
6. What are some ways that your LifeGroup can encourage one another to delight in God’s Word? To understand it? To turn from looking at worthless things?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:34. Talk with one another about how the Lord gives us understanding and what it looks like to observe his law with our whole hearts.
