## **LifeGroup Discussion**

### **Psalm 119:81-88**

1. Read Psalm 119:81. Have there been times in your life when you struggled to have hope in the days ahead? How can our confidence in heaven give us hope for today?
2. Psalm 119:82 reveals honest struggle from the heart of the psalmist. He asks, "When will you comfort me?" Is it OK for us to question God? Why or why not?
3. Read verses 87-88. When the psalmist's enemies attacked him, what kept him safe and secure?
4. Ephesians 6:10-20 is a good passage for Christians who are looking for a battle plan for spiritual warfare. How does Paul urge believers to engage in spiritual battle in those verses?
5. Spiritual warfare is fought on three fronts: the battle with the flesh, the battle with the world, and the battle with the spiritual realm. Which of these do you struggle with most often?
6. In regards to the three fronts of spiritual warfare mentioned above, should we engage each attack differently? If so, how?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:88. What is it that gives us the ability to keep God's testimonies?
