## **LifeGroup Discussion**

Date: April 16, 2017

**Psalm 119:89-96**

1. Why was death more than a “part” of Jesus’ ministry? In what ways was it the purpose of his ministry?
2. How did the Word of God give Jesus confidence to trust the Father on Palm Sunday? How did it give him the faith to follow the Father’s plan in Gethsemane and on Golgotha?
3. Read Psalm 119:108. A freewill offering was given out of desire, not compulsion. What was the offering that the psalmist gave? What kinds of offerings can you freely give to the Lord?
4. Pay attention to verse 110. Even though the wicked have laid a snare, the Psalmist does not stray from God’s commands. Have you been tempted in the past to ignore God’s Word when life became difficult? How did you handle those situations?
5. One of Pastor Craig’s points from last week was “run towards the light.” How can you run “towards the light” that God has given? How are you doing that right now?
6. God’s light shines in the darkest of places. How can you use the word of God to shine into dark places today? Where are some dark places where you can shine the light of God?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:105. What path is God lighting for you to travel down right now?
