## **LifeGroup Discussion**

Date: April 30, 2017

**Psalm 119:129-136**

1. In what ways does the Bible give us light? How can you share that light with others?
2. The Psalmist writes, "Your testimonies are wonderful; therefore my soul keeps them." How have you tested God's testimonies and found them to be "wonderful?"
3. Read Psalm 119:132. How does the psalmist pray for the Lord to turn to him? What is the difference between praying for God's grace, and hoping for God to respond to us according to our own works?
4. The Bible gives you purpose. What purpose have you found from God's word? If you have not found your "purpose" in God's kingdom, what can you do to discover it?
5. In verse 136 the psalmist shares, "my eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep your law." How can we cultivate a passion for the lost that would drive us to tears?
6. If you were given the task of showing someone how this particular passage of Scripture pointed to Jesus, how would you do it? How could you use these verses to share the gospel?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 119:130. Discuss how God's word has given you understanding.
