Romans 5:10

1. According to Genesis 1:26-27, people were created in the image of God. How has sin affected the way that people reflect the image of God?
2. In what ways has sin broken the relationship between God and man?
3. How did Jesus' death create the opportunity for people to be saved from their sins? How does his resurrection give us confidence in Jesus' offer?
4. Read John 10:10. What do you learn about Jesus and his plans for you in this passage of Scripture? How does this verse speak against those who view Christianity as restrictive and boring?
5. How did Ian describe 1 Timothy 4:10 and Romans 5:1 last week? What is the role of faith in the process of salvation?
6. Read Romans 5:6-8. Last week's sermon focused on salvation. Discuss with one another how God's love is shown by sending Jesus to die for us while we were his enemies.
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Romans 5:10. What does it mean to be reconciled to God?
