LifeGroup Discussion

Date: July 30, 2017

Isaiah 6:1-8

1. What if the call to missions comes in response to our willingness to go? How would this alter the way that you approach the call of God on ministers and missionaries and on your own life?
2. Pastor Craig pointed out that Isaiah experienced the Lord during an especially difficult time in his life. Can you name a hard time in your life when God made his presence known to you?
3. Isaiah received his call to ministry during worship. Some have received their call in other ways (Paul and Moses, for example), what are some reasons that worship is a time when God calls many of his saints to service?
4. What conditions did Isaiah place on God's call before he said he would go? How have you limited God by your conditions?
5. In what ways did Isaiah respond when he experienced the Lord in His glory? How do you think you would respond if you experienced the Lord face to face?
6. The cross of Christ makes it possible for us to be brought near to a holy God. How does the cross also add urgency to the missional call of God?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Isaiah 6:8. How can respond to this verse as a family?
