## **LifeGroup Discussion**

Date: August 6, 2017

### **Proverbs 5:1-23**

1. In what ways does our culture make it difficult to remain pure? What are some everyday temptations that you face?
2. Pastor Craig focused much of Sunday's sermon on marriage, but Solomon was giving these parables to his young son. How do these verses apply to single people as well as married people?
3. Solomon warns his son that the steps of the forbidden woman go down to death. How does sexual sin draw us away from God and the people of God?
4. The advice of Solomon to his son is the same as the advice many parents have shared with their children throughout history. Why do young people (and many people not so young) refuse to honor wisdom regarding sexual purity?
5. Read verse 18. How have you found the path of righteousness to grow brighter and brighter.
6. Holiness is a biblical expectation of followers of Jesus (1 Peter 1:16). How can you guard against legalism? How does the cross of Christ protect us from arrogance in our pursuit of holiness?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 51:10. Talk about how the Lord's supper serves as a reminder of our holiness.
