LifeGroup Discussion

Date: December 3, 2017

Genesis 3:1-15

1. Adam and Eve sinned after they were tempted by Satan to not believe God's word. In what ways are you tempted to not trust God's word in your own life?
2. Some question who the serpent of Genesis really is, but the Bible helps us to answer that question. According to Revelation 12:7-12, who is the serpent? What is his goal? Why will he not succeed?
3. Read Hebrews 4:14-16. What do we learn about Jesus from this passage. How can this passage help us to share the gospel with others?
4. Temptation comes at us from all sides. How does Jesus' victory over Satan empower you to resist temptation in your own life?
5. Sometimes spiritual attack in our life is not primarily in the form of temptation, but depression over past sins or present realities. How can Christ's victory help you to find victory over guilt from your past or despair for your future?
6. Christmas is a celebration of our Savior's arrival. What do you learn about the character of God that he would promise a Savior before he pronounced curses upon mankind and the rest of creation.
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Galatians 4:4-5. Talk together about the blessing that is our spiritual adoption.
