Discussion Questions

There is no LifeGroup on December 24. Use these questions in your family or for your own personal growth.

Genesis 21:22-34

1. We speak of God being everlasting or eternal. What does that mean?
2. Read Revelation 1:1-8. In what ways does John describe Jesus in this passage? With what titles does Jesus describe himself? What do we learn about the character and attributes of Jesus from this passage?
3. Why would Abraham have called on God as the Everlasting God in Genesis 22? How did that title for God have bearing on Abraham's particular situation?
4. The eternal nature of God is a powerful apologetic tool. How might we defend God's eternality to those who argue for naturalistic evolution?
5. Why must God be eternal if he is going to offer eternal life? Why couldn't a finite god offer eternal life?
6. Has there ever been a time when you needed to be reminded that God would never leave you? Talk about a time in your own life when God's eternal nature was especially comforting.
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Revelation 1:8.
