## **Discussion Questions**

Date: January 28, 2018

### **Mark 1:9-11**

1. At his baptism, Jesus was affirmed and confirmed by the Father and the anointing of the Holy Spirit. This time of setting apart marked the beginning of Jesus's public ministry and prepared him for his testing in the wilderness. How can you look back over your life and see the ways that God prepared you beforehand for tests and trials that you have endured?
2. Prophets spoke God's word to the people. How does the prophetic ministry of Jesus affect your spiritual walk?
3. The role of priests in the Old Covenant was to intercede with God on behalf of the people. Though they preached and explained God's word, their primary role was to offer sacrifices for the sins of the people. How does Jesus fulfill this priestly role?
4. Kings have the responsibility to bring order to their kingdom and care for the people over whom they rule. How does Jesus's kingly ministry give you confidence and hope during hard days?
5. Read Psalm 2. How does Jesus fulfill the prophecy of this Psalm? What does this Psalm proclaim God's king will do?
6. As you share the gospel with others, how do the three offices of Jesus (prophet, priest, and king) affect your gospel presentation?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 2:6. Discuss the ways that this verse was fulfilled during Jesus's baptism.
