## **Discussion Questions**

Date: February 18, 2018

### **Mark 1:16-20**

1. The first four disciples that Mark mentioned were fishermen before they became Jesus's disciples. How have you seen God use people who were not educated or trained as pastors to do his work? How does this give you encouragement for how God could use you?
2. Most likely, Jesus's disciples were already serving before they were called out specifically to their special kind of ministry. How are you serving Jesus right now? How can you even honor him on your job?
3. As the disciples were handling their own business, Jesus called out to them. How do you listen for the Lord's call in your own life?
4. Healthy people grow and change as they age. What does it look like to grow in character and ability as a disciple of Jesus as you age spiritually?
5. The disciples left all they had to follow Jesus. They trusted in God to meet their financial needs. How does tithing help us learn to trust God to meet our financial needs?
6. Lots of people talk about doing something great for Jesus "one day." Why is it dangerous to put off serving the Lord?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Mark 1:17. Talk together about what it means to be a follower of Jesus and a fisher of men.
