## **Discussion Questions**

### **Mark 8:22-26**

1. Last Sunday, pastor Craig talked mostly about sanctification. However, an important aspect of Mark 8:22-26 is that people brought the blind man to Jesus. Who are some of the important people in your life that helped you to meet Jesus?
2. Jesus healed in a variety of ways throughout the gospels. What are some reasons why Jesus might not have healed in the same way each time? What are some reasons that a personal touch was an important part of many of Jesus's healings?
3. The Bible says that after the man "looked up," Jesus touched him and opened his eyes fully. How has "looking up" to Jesus opened your eyes?
4. The man first saw people walking, but they looked like trees. How were some of the truths of God's word hard to understand when you first came to Christ? Did God's truths sometimes look like something other than good or joyful?
5. Read John's account of a man born blind in John 9:1-7. Why does Jesus say that this man was blind? How was God glorified through his healing? How was God glorified through your salvation?
6. Read Ephesians 4:14-15. According to these verses, what is the opposite of growing up in Christ? How can we avoid being tossed about by every wind and wave of doctrine?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 146:8. Talk together about how God has opened your eyes and made you righteous.
