### **Romans 1:8-10**

1. In Paul's greeting to the Romans in 1:1-7 he addresses the believers there as "called to belong to Jesus Christ," and as those "who are loved by God and called to be saints." How do these verses apply to you and to other members of our church?
2. In Romans 1:8, Paul says that the faith of the Roman church was known in all the world. What kinds of things should a church be known for? How does a good reputation enable a church to better fulfill God's mission?
3. Read Romans 13:8-14. What does it look like to fulfill the law through love within the church? How can you show your love toward others?
4. Read 1 John 5:14-15. What confidence can we have in the effectiveness of prayer? How should a church engage in prayer for her members? How have you benefited from the prayers of your church?
5. Pastor Craig talked last week about how Paul expected the church at Rome to persevere. How has Malvern Hill become a spiritual home for you? How might others draw strength and encouragement from the perseverance of Malvern Hill?
6. Take some time in LifeGroup to talk about why you are thankful for Malvern Hill. How has our church blessed you and how can you be a blessing to others through Malvern Hill?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Philippians 1:3-4. How do you pray for your church family? Take time to pray for your church today.
