Discussion Questions

Date: November 30, 2019

Psalm 105:1-7

1. Did Thanksgiving Day prove to be a day for you to give thanks to the Lord for his blessings, or did the busyness of the holiday keep you distracted from its real purpose? How can you create time in your life to thank God more regularly?
2. Psalm 105 was written by David and was sung when the Ark of the Covenant was brought into Jerusalem from the house of Obed-Edom. Read 1 Chronicles 13:8-14. Why was the Ark not in Jerusalem? What lessons were learned about God's holiness from the event recorded in 1 Chronicles 13?
3. Pastor Craig urged us on Sunday to give thanks to the Lord. How is it missional when we publicly acknowledge God for his blessings in our life?
4. Watch Nick Foles' interview on YouTube here: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZX-EDS2gnk>. How did Nick Foles testify to God's faithfulness even in the midst of disappointment? How can you testify to God's faithfulness daily?
5. Thomas Jefferson famously cut the miracle stories out of the New Testament and created his own version that focused only on Jesus as a good moral man. How do miracles testify to God's greatness and why are miracles essential to Christianity?
6. Read Hebrews 9:27. We don't talk about judgment often, but it is a reality. How can you warn others of the judgment of God to come? How can such warnings prove beneficial in missions and evangelism?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Psalm 105:7. Discuss together how far reaching the judgments of God are.
