Discussion Questions

Hebrews 10:19-39

1. COVID-19 has created a unique situation for church attendance. How has COVID-19 affected your attendance in church? If you have not been attending regularly, what has to change before you plan to resume regular attendance?
2. Read Acts 2:42-25. How did these early Christians live together as the church? In what ways might this view of the church challenge typical American definitions of the church?
3. Read Matthew 16:18. Who created the church? Do you think God is dishonored by those who claim to follow him but do not belong to a local church?
4. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. What is God's expectation about church attendance in these verses? How does our regular attendance affect the way we experience accountability and provide accountability to others?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 14:24-25. How might unbelievers who enter our worship services be brought to Christ? How can your presence in worship services help lead others toward Jesus?
6. Consider the following statement: "Church should be your excuse for missing everything else." How do you respond to this statement?
7. Family verse: Read and memorize Hebrews 10:25. Discuss what steps you can take to make regular church attendance a greater priority in your own life.
