Discussion Questions

Genesis 1:3, 1:27, 3:15

1. Pastor Adam mentioned several verses that elaborate on the idea of light in the Bible. What were they? Which is your favorite and why?
2. Light is something we use to measure change. Why is change important? What do you struggle spiritually to change?
3. We have freedom gifted to us as image bearers of God. But freedom is not a license to do whatever we wish. What is biblical freedom? Why is it biblical freedom important?
4. God knew from eternity past that sin would enter the world. When Adam and Eve were about to sin for the first time, why didn't God step in and stop them?
5. Genesis 3:15 is called the protoevangelium, the first promise of salvation through Christ. Why was it just for God to give a promise instead of punishment when Adam and Eve sinned?
6. Read and memorize Genesis 3:15. Discuss with your family the significance of this verse as the first gospel proclamation.
