

1. We only have one more week left in our *Summer in the Psalms* series, how have the Psalms studied so far this summer impacted you? What have you learned or how have the sermons challenged you?
2. David wrote Psalm 122 and said, “I was glad when they said to me, let us go to the house of the Lord!” What robs you of your joy in worship? How can you find more joy in gathering with your church?
3. The peace the Psalmist wrote about is more than the absence of war—it indicates a condition where everyone (and everything) can flourish and live undisturbed. How should we pray for other believers to experience this kind of peace so they can worship and evangelize freely?

4. Read Isaiah 2:1-5. What does Isaiah prophesy about Jerusalem in the future? How is this prophecy about more than just present day Israel?

5. On Sunday, Pastor Craig concluded by asking, “Is the peace of Christ enough for you?” What can Christians do to be satisfied in Christ? How might we experience the peace of Christ even in the midst of chaos?

6. Read *The Lord's Prayer* in Matthew 6:9-13. How will God's kingdom come to earth? How does this prayer instruct us to live as citizens of God's kingdom?

7. The Great Commission urges us to go and make disciples. How can inviting someone to church be a way for you to share the gospel with them?
