1. Genealogies in the Bible are filled with names that are difficult to pronounce and we are often tempted to skip over them when reading. What is some of the value to reading the Bible's genealogies?

2. On Sunday, Pastor Craig pointed out that Jesus was God's plan from the beginning. Read Genesis 3:14-15, how do these verses prophesy the coming and ultimate victory of Jesus.

3. Further evidence for Jesus being God's forever plan is found in Revelation 13. Read Revelation 13:5-8. What does verse 8 teach you about the plan of God in Jesus before the foundation of the world? How does God's sovereign plan over your salvation give you comfort during difficult days?

4. Luke traces Jesus's genealogy through the family line of Joseph all the way back through Abraham and even to Adam. In Matthew, the genealogy of Jesus is traced through Mary's lineage and includes a prostitute (Rahab), a widow (Ruth), and even mentions that Solomon's mother was the wife of Uriah (who was murdered by David). How do the various names mentioned in Jesus's genealogies show the inclusive invitation of God's salvation through Jesus?

5. Though Jesus is the Savior for all, he will only save those who call upon his name (Romans 10:13). What is necessary for a person to understand for them to be saved?

6. Jesus died to save you from the punishment of sin, but also to set you free from the power of sin. Read Romans 6:1-4 and 6:20-23. According to these verses, how is your life different because of Christ? Why can you live a holy life?

7. Inclusivism is a way to say that all religious paths can lead to salvation. Exclusivism is the belief that there is only one truth path to salvation. How is Christianity exclusive in its application, but inclusive in its invitation?
