4. Read Galatians 5:16-17. How do these verses describe walking in the spirit? Why is it necessary to fight against the desires of our flesh to live in the Spirit?

Luke 4:14-15

1. Pastor Craig has emphasized the Holy Spirit several times in the past few sermons. Do you think that teaching about, and understanding of, the Holy Spirit is neglected today? Why or why not?

5. Ministering in the power of the Holy Spirit means going where the Spirit leads, but also trusting the Spirit to do what only the Spirit can do. How does trusting the Spirit with the results of your ministry free you from worry?

2. Jesus was set apart by the Holy Spirit at his baptism, he was full of the Holy Spirit when he was led into the wilderness, and he was in the power of the Holy Spirit when he returned to Galilee to minister in their synagogues. What are some reasons why Luke might draw so much attention to the ministry of the Holy Spirit?

6. The Bible was written by human authors under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. How can you trust that your time in the Word of God will give you fellowship with the Holy Spirit?

3. Often, the idea of being filled with the Holy Spirit can feel a little mystical. Read Ephesians 5:15-21. How does Paul explain the filling of the Holy Spirit in these verses?

7. God is Trinitarian, existing as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Because God is eternal and wholly other than us, every attempt to explain the Trinity eventually breaks down, but some explanations help more than others. Share an explanation of the Trinity that you have read or heard in the past that helped you to try to understand it better?
