

4. Read Isaiah 61:1-3. Why might the Jewish people of Jesus's day have expected the Messiah to be a political or military ruler based on these verses? How does Jesus fulfill Isaiah's vision even though he was not what the people expected.

Luke 4:16-21

1. Luke points out that Jesus came to Nazareth, "where he had been brought up," to speak in their synagogue. Do you find it easier to share the hope of Jesus among those you know or among strangers? Why?

5. Jesus was the promised Savior, but he was not what was expected. How has God answered your prayers in the past without sending you what you expected?

2. The Holy Spirit has been a focus in the last few weeks. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in Luke 4:16-21?

6. On Sunday, Pastor Craig said an encounter with God's word requires a response. Read Psalm 106:12. What response came when God's people believed his word during the Exodus? What are other ways you might be required to respond to God's word?

3. Jesus stood up and read from what we now know to be Isaiah 61. Read Isaiah 59:20-21. What had God promised to the people of Israel if they would turn from their sin (transgression)? How was Jesus the fulfillment to this promise?

7. The gospel is the good news about Jesus, but in some ways Jesus himself is the gospel because salvation brings about a unity with Christ through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Beyond the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, what are some of the other gifts granted to Christians at their salvation?
