6. Read Mark 1:35-39 for a more detailed account of Jesus getting away from the crowd in Capernaum. How do you think it impacted Jesus's disciples to know that Jesus was praying in private as well as public? Think about whether your private life matches your public life. How often do people find you getting away to spend time with the Lord?

7. The Kingdom of God can be defined as "the people of God in the place of God under the rule and blessing of God." According to this definition, how is the church the representation of God's kingdom on earth?

Luke 4:42-44

1. Luke tells us when the sun was setting, Jesus began healing people of disease and casting out demons. In Luke 4:42, he begins with, "when it was day," suggesting he had labored all night. Jesus seems to have balanced committed labor with regular rest and restoration. How can you balance those things?

2. Even though Luke 4:42-44 doesn't speak of a Sabbath rest, the idea of rest is still present. How does our rest show our dependence upon the Lord?

3. Jesus's work and message resonated well with the people of Capernaum and they didn't want him to leave, but Jesus did not heed their request. How can you practice discernment to know when you should listen to the advice of others and when you should ignore it?
