## Luke 2:1-7

1. How can you utilize the Christmas season to tell others about Christ? What are some creative ways you have seen others share the gospel during the holidays?

2. Jesus was born in Bethlehem, the house of bread. Read John 6:31-35. What was manna and what was its purpose? How is Jesus the better bread?

3. Read Hebrews 5:11-14. How does the writer of Hebrews use food metaphors to refer to the Word of God? In what ways has the Word nourished your soul in the past?

4. At the last supper, Jesus used bread as a metaphor for his broken body. Why was Jesus's death necessary for the forgiveness of our sins.

5. During the Lord's Supper, we reflect on the death of Christ, but we also "commune" with one another and celebrate the fellowship of believers. Why do we sometimes reflect only on the personal aspect of the Lord's Supper and not the communal aspect?

6. As we seek to reach Kershaw County over the next year, consider how the Word of God brings hope to the hopeless. How can you meet people in their darkness and despair and bring them the hope of Christ?

7. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-7. Christmas is incredibly important, but what does Paul say is of first importance? How can we tie the story of Christmas to the message of the gospel?
