4. Jesus is given several different names and titles throughout the Bible. Why are the different names and titles important, and how do they give us a more clear vision of what God has done for us in Christ? For help, consider the following verses: Matthew 22:21, Isaiah 7:14; 9:6-11.

Luke 2:8-21

1. The Christmas story has become commonplace in American culture. Even Linus has recited it for all to hear. How is the story of Christmas dear to your heart? What steps did you take to make it a central part of your Christmas celebrations this year?

5. Read Luke 2:14. With whom is God well pleased? How can a person become one with whom God is well-pleased?

2. The Bible says the glory of the Lord shown around the angels in the night sky. The glory of the Lord was present among the Israelites as a pillar of clouds in the day and a pillar of fire at night when they escaped Egypt (Exodus 13:21-22). Why does God's glory cause fear? How can the fearful glory of God also bring hope?

6. The Shepherds did not only hear about Jesus, they were invited to spend time with Jesus. How did this birth proclamation point to some of the aspects of Jesus's future ministry?

3. On Sunday, Pastor Craig said it is good news that God has spoken. What would be different in our world if God had not chosen to reveal himself and his will? Because God has spoken, what is our responsibility?

7. Read Genesis 15:1. This is the first place in the Bible where someone is told to not be afraid. What reason did God give Abraham to not fear? How was Jesus's birth a fulfillment of God's promises to Abraham in Genesis 15:2-6?
