4. Read Revelation 5:13-14. How does the worship of Jesus on the first Palm Sunday point toward worship around the throne of God in heaven? How do the depictions of worship in John 12 and Revelation 5 cause you to think about your own habits of worship?

5. John 12:16 says Jesus's disciples didn't understand all of his actions until after he had been glorified. How has your understanding of Jesus and of his word grown as you have known him longer and studied more?

6. The Triumphal Entry is only a triumph for those who worship Jesus. Many people have never experienced Jesus entering their lives. Who are you praying for to be saved? How might you use the lessons from this passage of Scripture to share your faith?

7. Read Psalm 95:1-6. When you consider this description of God as king, what characteristics make him most recognizable and worthy of worship?

John 12:12-19

1. When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, he was worshiped. However, there were many in Jerusalem who did not recognize Jesus as the Messiah. 2. Look carefully at John 12:12-19. What is the main idea of this passage? How does the main idea of this passage apply to believers today?

3. Jesus rode into Jerusalem, willing to be found by anyone who would seek him. Where did you encounter Jesus in your life last week? In what ways will you seek him this week?
