Luke 7:1-10

1. The centurion in the story had an uncommon belief in the power of Jesus. Who have you known in your life who seemed to have an uncommon belief in the power of Jesus? How did that person impact your life and the way you understand what it means to be a follower of Jesus?

2. Much of the focus in this passage is on Jesus and the centurion, but others came to Jesus and pleaded with him to heal the centurion's servant (7:3-5). How does this resemble intercessory prayer? How should intercessory prayer play a role in the regular prayer life of Christians?

3. On Sunday, Pastor Craig said that prayer is a conversation. Why do Christians often find it difficult to consistently "talk" with the Lord in prayer? What steps could you take to make your prayer life more consistent? How can you put 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 into practice?

4. The centurion in Luke 7 believed in the power of Jesus's words. Hebrews 4:12 is one of the most important verses in the Bible for understanding the power of God's Word. How can you put that verse into practice in your daily life?

5. Last week, the sermon included Jesus's words from Luke 6:46 that warn us to not call him "Lord" unless we are going to do what he says. How does our obedience to the Word of God show our belief in the power of the Word and our faith in God's willingness to work through the Word?

6. Hebrews 11:1 is the classic definition of faith. How does this verse define faith? How can this verse be applied practically in your prayer life?

7. Ephesians 2:8-9 explains that salvation comes by faith, and that faith is a gift of God, not a result of our works. James 2:17 says that faith without deeds is dead. How are Ephesians 2 and James 2 both true at the same time?
