Psalm 77:11-12

1. On Sunday, we celebrated our senior adults. How have adults older than you aided you in your spiritual journey? How can you serve as a conduit to connect older and younger people together?
2. Pastor Buster shared on Sunday about the ways he has seen the Lord answer prayers at Malvern Hill. What about his testimony stood out most to you? What are you praying for the Lord to do at Malvern Hill today?
3. Psalm 77:11-12 encourages us to remember the deeds of the Lord and to meditate upon his works. What can you do to help you better remember God's works? How does meditating upon God's works impact your own life?

4. Read Psalm 145:1-9. This is another Psalm that speaks of God's great deeds. What are some of the great things God has done in Scripture for which he deserves praise?

5. God does great things beyond Scripture. What are some of God's works in the present that he deserves praise for?

6. There is a temptation to celebrate the work of the present and forget the work in the past. How can Malvern Hill celebrate all that God is doing today and will do in the future without neglecting to honor the past? Who in our church can you thank today for their investment in the church or in your life personally?

7. Pastor Craig's last point on Sunday—don't get stuck in the past—was taken from Psalm 77:14. How does a commitment to missions and the Great Commission keep a church moving forward and protect it from being stuck in the past?
