#### Acts 1:6-11

1. Much of what was discussed last week concerned building a new building and reaching Kershaw County with the gospel. What about this makes you excited? What makes you nervous?

2. Read Acts 1:1-2. To whom was this book written? Read Luke 1:1-4. What are the connections between Luke and Acts?

3. Read Acts 1:3-5. How long was Jesus with the disciples after his resurrection? How does this help Christians to defend the validity of the resurrection against those who doubt it?

4. According to Acts 1:6, the disciples were especially concerned with knowing when the Lord would restore the kingdom to Israel. How did Jesus respond in the following verses? Why are we often tempted to spend time on what we can't know rather than on obeying the commands we are clearly given?

5. In Acts 1:8, Jesus tells us, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you." Read the remainder of the verse. What is the purpose for which Christians are given the power of the Holy Spirit? How should the knowledge of that empowerment encourage you as you share the gospel with others?

6. Read Acts 2:1-4. How was the promise of Jesus in Acts 1:8 fulfilled in these verses? What was the immediate action that followed the coming of the Holy Spirit, according to Acts 2:14-41?

7. The sermon ended with the question, "What are we going to do?" That question has a corporate dimension, as the church wrestles with the next steps it should take, but it also has personal dimensions for every believer. What can/should you do this week to be a part of fulfilling Jesus's Great Commission?
