4. Read James 1:22-25. What does this passage teach about hearing and learning the Word of God? Why is hearing it not enough?

5. The Great Commission drives much of what we do at Malvern Hill, but it is about more than evangelism. Read Matthew 28:20. Why is teaching an important component of the Great Commission? What specifically is to be taught?

6. On Sunday, Pastor Craig spoke about the importance of work. Do you believe work is celebrated today in the same way it was in the past? Read Genesis 1:26-28. What were God's first commands to Adam and Eve after their creation? How should this impact the way we view work?

7. Some AI proponents promise that people will one day work even less than they do now. How might human beings reflect God's image less faithfully if they cease to labor?

1. What is a successful family? How is (or should) the world's definition of a successful family be different from a biblical view of a successful family?

2. When you consider Psalm 128, what blessings do you find? What are the qualifications to receive those blessings?

3. Read Proverbs 9:10 and Psalm 14:1. What is the difference between wisdom and foolishness? How do Christians practically behave as fools when they do not seek God in prayer or walk according to his Word?
