Psalm 66:1-7

1. We have just come through the 4th of July. How and why do you praise the Lord for where you live?

2. The Psalmist commands us to shout for joy. What is the difference between joy and happiness? How and why can you have joy even in difficult or dark days?

3. Pastor Craig encouraged us on Sunday to live in the present. How can harping on the past or looking only to the future rob you of the opportunity to celebrate God in the present? How can living in the present help you to care well for others in your life?

4. Read Philippians 2:10-11 and Psalm 66:3. What do we learn about God's greatness by the fact that even his enemies will worship him?

5. In Psalm 66:5, the Psalmist says, "Come and see." How can the testimony of what God has done in your church point people to Christ? What can you show people about your experience with God? How is your changed life a testimony of God's work?

6. Psalm 66:6 is a testament to God's work in delivering Israel from Egypt through the Exodus. How can the works of God in the Bible and in history be used to point people to Christ?

7. What do you have to praise God for? Take time to praise him among your LifeGroup today. He is worthy.
