## Luke 7:11-17

1. We spent the summer months in the Psalms. What sermon or Psalm stood out to you the most this summer? How have you put those lessons into practice?
2. Jesus saw a woman and had compassion. Have you been tempted to see people in need and turn away rather than help? How can you minister to people in need around you?
3. When Jesus approached the grieving mother, he said, "Do not weep." Those words must have sounded pretty outlandish to her, and yet they were trustworthy because they came from Jesus. How have you found God's word to be trustworthy, even when it didn't seem to make sense?

4. Jesus approached the woman to comfort her. Read Job 42:1-6. How did Job respond after the Lord drew near to him? Why can and should you find comfort in God's presence?

5. Jesus touched the funeral bier, commanded him to "arise," and the man sat up and began to speak. How does this miracle differ from the way Jesus healed the centurion's servant in Luke 7:6-10? How are you encouraged to know that even in his miracles, Jesus acts in each situation in a way that is unique to the people involved?

6. The "gift" for this woman was the resuscitation of her son. The people who witnessed this miraculous blessing glorified God. How do you use the gifts and blessings God has given you to glorify him?

7. Share about a time when God saw you in your moment of need and met you there. Take time in your group to pray for the places where each of you may need God to meet you today.
