### Luke 8:1-3

1. In a healthy, growing church, there are always many jobs to fill. On Sunday, September 13, our church will host a ministry fair called *Pew to Purpose* during the LifeGroup hour. Take time today to discuss the various roles that members of your LifeGroup might feel called to volunteer for during the ministry fair.
2. In Luke 7:47, Jesus explains that he who is forgiven little loves little, and he who is forgiven much loves much. How do you think a person who has been rescued from demonic spirits might love Jesus? How should the church think about demonic possession today?
3. On Sunday, Pastor Craig reminded everyone that though you need Jesus, you are not Jesus. Talk about a time when you tried to be the savior rather than relying on Jesus.

4. Read Mark 1:14-25. How did Jesus begin his ministry? How was the beginning of his ministry similar to what we see in Luke 8?
5. Luke 8 mentions "the twelve." Read Luke 6:12-16. Who were the twelve? The twelve are also called his disciples or apostles. Apostle means "sent ones." How are some people uniquely sent by God to do his work? How does the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20 send all Christians in a general sense?
6. From the text, it is obvious that the followers of Jesus came from a variety of different backgrounds. What steps should a church take to try to reach different sorts of people from different sorts of backgrounds with the gospel? How have you been effective at reaching people who are different from you?
7. You are saved to serve. What does it mean to be a servant? What different kinds of service are found in Luke 8:1-3? How might someone's greatest service be in supporting the service of others?
