Psalm 90:12-17

1. As you consider wisdom this week, talk about some of the wisest people you have known personally. What set them apart from others? How can you be more like those wise people?
2. Psalm 90 was written by Moses. Read Psalm 90:1. How does Moses describe the Lord in this verse? How can this description of God's love and care impact the way you live as a follower of Christ in difficult days?
3. On Sunday, Pastor Craig explained you are safe in the presence of God. Read Matthew 14:22-29. Why was it safer for Peter to be out of the boat than it was for him to be in the boat in the middle of the storm?

4. Moses says a thousand years are as a day to the Lord because he is timeless. How does God's power over time and creation help you to trust him when you are in a season of waiting?

5. In Psalm 90:7, Moses speaks of God's wrath and anger. Why is the subject of God's wrath and anger often avoided? Why should we talk about God's wrath? What role should the wrath and anger of God have in our evangelism?

6. Read Proverbs 9:10. How does an appropriate reverence of the Lord lead to wisdom? How should wisdom drive us to worship?

7. How can Psalm 90:16-17 be a prayer for you, your family, and our church? What work are you praying for the Lord to establish through the work of your hands?
