LifeGroup Discussion Date: February 19, 2017

Psalm 119:49-56

1. The psalmist prays by reminding God of his words. In what ways might praying the Word of God back to him help your prayer life?
2. Psalm 119:51 says, “The insolent utterly deride me, but I do not turn away from your law.” What would give the psalmist so much confidence in God’s Word?
3. The theme of this stanza is, “The Lord is my victory.” How does the psalmist claim God’s victory throughout this stanza?
4. What are the names or titles of God that give you the greatest comfort during hard times?
5. Without faith it is impossible to please God. Read Ephesians 6:16. What role does faith play in spiritual warfare?
6. Psalm 119:54 says that God’s laws have been the songs of the captive. When has singing God’s praises helped you to experience God’s victory?
7. Family verse: Read Psalm 119:50. Talk together about how the promise of God gives life and comfort in hard times.
