Scholarship Application Guidelines and Notes:

1. Scholarships are available for members of Malvern Hill Baptist Church or those students who have been active in the Student Ministry for at least three months.
2. Financial assistance is available for student ministry events at the following levels:
 - a. Mission Fuge, Disciple Now Weekend, and Ski Trip – 100% Assistance Available
 - b. Other Events – 50% Assistance Available
3. Student participation in Malvern Hill’s Student Ministry is a factor in the scholarship process. As Christ says, "One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much" (Luke 16:10). We expect our scholarship recipients to participate in our student ministry in the following areas:
 - a. LifeGroups
 - b. Sunday morning corporate worship
 - c. Wednesday student worship
 - d. Fundraisers
 - e. Occasional student events
4. Students who receive a scholarship are expected to participate in the event. Because of non-refundable deposits and pre-payments, the church still has to pay even if the student chooses not to participate. If a student withdraws after a deadline (unless it is due to a family illness or death), his or her decision will factor into future scholarship applications.
5. This application will be reviewed and voted on by the Scholarship Committee.
6. All scholarship applications are due one week prior to the event’s deposit deadline.
7. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to revise or modify these guidelines at any time. Final determination of scholarships and amounts are at their discretion.
