Thank you again and I love you all!

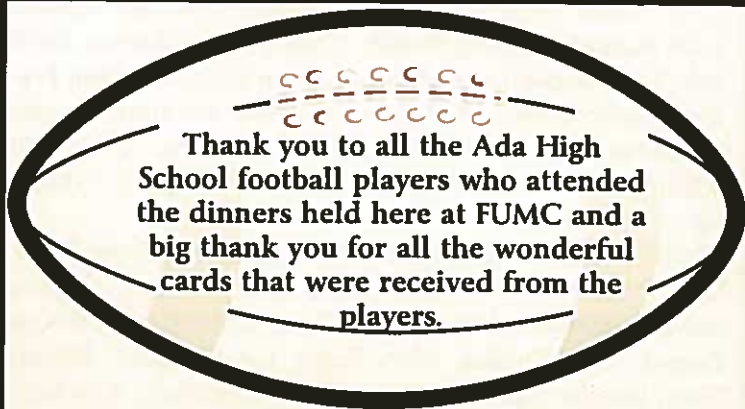

ETHICS

IN AMERICA THEN (B.I. Before the Internet) AND NOW

Bill Chapman will lead a group discussion based on the critically acclaimed Public Broadcasting Series titled "Ethics in America", produced in 1988 and "Ethics in America II", produced in 2008. In both productions hypothetical cases are debated and agonized over by eminent leaders from government, business, science and academia. Both series explore gripping ethical dilemmas using the time-honored Socratic Dialogue format. The format of these four classes will be to spend the first half of the class watching one of the videos and the second half of the class discussing the ethical issues raised and debated in the video.



OUR STORY

(The History of our foundation)

The Foundation Charter was granted by the Oklahoma Secretary of State in September 1970. The purpose of the Foundation corporation was stated as being exclusively for the benefit of The First United Methodist Church of Ada, Oklahoma, its members, employees, programs and physical properties. The Foundation is a tax exempt charitable organization.

Membership in the Foundation is granted to any individual, organization, or legal entity making a contribution of at least \$25 a year. All Foundation members are entitled to attend and vote at any membership meeting and have one vote per membership. A Board of Trustees governs the Foundation. The Board of Trustees can have a maximum of twenty members. No Trustee or member of the Foundation shall benefit from any income or earnings of the Foundation.

The financial assets of the Foundation have grown from an initial amount of \$350 to a current amount of one million dollars. Financial assets have been received by the Foundation by gifts, bequests, donations and memorials. Gifts and bequests may be made unrestricted or for a specific purpose so long as that purpose is in conformity with the charter and by-laws of the Foundation.
