

Locust Grove Baptist Church Reopening Procedures (Updated 7/23/20):

- Encourage anyone at risk (pre-existing conditions, elderly, etc.) or anyone who has been in contact in the last two weeks with someone who has Covid-19 to stay home and enjoy the Live Stream/ Facebook.
- Encourage those that do not feel comfortable to be in the large gathering to enjoy the Live Stream/ Facebook.
- Encourage anyone who is experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 to please worship with us from home.
 - Symptoms include:
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Cough
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
 - Fever or chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Fatigue
- Encourage social distancing (6 ft. or 2 arm lengths)
- Face coverings/ masks are **strongly recommended**, we can provide a mask for anyone that needs one.
- The Church will be at 50% seating capacity.
- All doors will be propped open for entrance and exit.

- Touchless hand sanitizer stations have been placed at every entrance.
- Extra cleaning of facilities, (especially high touch areas, doors, etc.)
- Remove all items not easily cleaned, (Hymn books, pens, offering envelopes, Lovenotes.)
- No congregational singing
- Dismiss by rows
- No Sunday School, Small Groups, Children's Church, Nursery currently.
- Only one weekly gathering, (Wednesday night Prayer Meeting and Bible Study will continue to be online only.)
- Collection plates will not be passed, they will be placed at the exit doors.
- No Meet & Greet time during the service.
- Encourage people to not gather after the service in the sanctuary. (Encourage social distancing outside.)
- Restrooms will be available only in the sanctuary with extra cleaning in place.
