We are serious about managing the spread of infection, but we need your help. We ask that your child stay home from school if...



- 1) They have had a fever (or any medication to reduce a fever) within the last 24 hours,
- 2) They have vomited or had loose stools within the last 24 hours,
- 3) They have started an antibiotic within the last 24 hours.

*If your child gets sick at school you will be notified to come pick her/him up as soon as possible, and we ask that they remain home at least 24 hours.

If your child needs to be given medication during school hours, the medicine must be left in the office and a permission form signed by the parent. Illnesses and absences can be reported directly to your teacher and/or to the office by email.
