Ephesians Daily Readings

Week One: The Mystery of God's Will Revealed

Monday, 1/21 Ephesians 1:1-2

The typical letter greeting of the day was from, to, and a blessing. How have you experienced the blessing, "grace and peace," in your life?

Tuesday, 1/22 Ephesians 1:3-6

God has chosen us in Christ to be holy and blameless before him in love. What does it mean to be holy and blameless before God?

Wednesday, 1/23 Ephesians 1:7-10

In Christ, God has lavished the riches of his grace on us. What is the mystery of God's will for the fullness of time that is now revealed?

Thursday, 1/24 Ephesians 1:11-14

The goal of what God has done for Jewish believers, “we,” and gentile believers, “you,” is that we might “Live for the praise of his glory.” What does that kind of living look like?

Friday, 1/25 Ephesians 1:15-19

Paul begins many of his letters with a prayer for his readers. What does he pray that the readers of this letter might comprehend?

Saturday, 1/26 Ephesians 1:20-23

How is God’s power at work in Christ? What is the relationship of Christ to the church?

Sunday, 1/27 Ephesians 1:1-23

Each Sunday your reading will be a review of the whole chapter so you can put the pieces together. For you, what is the big idea in chapter one?
