**Ephesians Daily Readings**

**Week 4: Maturity Looks like Christ (4:11-16)**

Monday, 2/11 Ephesians 4:1-6

In these verses, Paul points out some of what makes us one. What kind of life should we be living together to honor all that unifies us?

Tuesday, 2/12 Ephesians 4:7-10

Christ has given gifts to us. How does Christ have the authority to give us gifts?

Wednesday, 2/13 Ephesians 4:11-13

Paul lists some of the gifts that Christ has given us to build up his Body. What gift(s) has he given you and how you can use it/them for the work of ministry in the church and/or in mission beyond the church?

Thursday, 2/14 Ephesians 4:14-16

Paul challenges his readers to grow up “into Christ.” According to these verses what might be characteristics of a mature church?

Friday, 2/15 Ephesians 4:17-24

Paul is insistent that the old way of life must be given up if one is to be a follower of Christ. What lingers in your life that does not measure up to the likeness of Christ?

Saturday, 2/16 Ephesians 4:25-32

Paul lists a variety of ways Christians can fail to live as they ought. Which of these is the greatest threat to your living the Christian life?

Sunday, 2/17 Ephesians 4:1-32

As you reread the chapter today, notice how the Christian life is not lived in isolation, but rather is an ongoing interaction with other believers. Record the lesson, or insight, or action point that stands out for you.
