Sr Camp Details

Senior Camp (Those going into third, fourth, and fifth grade) goes on an exciting field trip four days a week. We will be using one of the following modes of transportation for field trips..... Calvary school bus, rented school bus or Calvary vans (with car seats for all required) to transport the children. The campers will be "In House" for special activities during the other days of camp. During in house days Sr Campers will be working on S.T.E.M. activities as well as practicing for a play. S.T.E.M. stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. S.T.E.M. develops children's problem solving, critical thinking, and social interaction skills.

Senior Camp is designed for a two fold purpose – First, we understand that parents have to work in the summer, so you need child care for your child. But secondly, we want to share a summer where kids can grow closer to Jesus, learn to love each other, have engaging learning experiences, and giggle and laugh in the process. Our priority is to have a summer drenched in Jesus during Senior Camp! We will openly share about the Bible and a personal relationship with Jesus during camp. This includes Bible time in the camp room and regular chapel times, filled with praise & worship! Feel free to visit our center website (www.calvarychristianschool.org) or church website (www.calvaryfullgospel.org) for more information!

Camp Calendars- We have trip/activity calendars established for you. However, they are *subject to change* due to weather or other circumstances. Any updates/changes will be posted both in the foyer and at the camp room. This year – we are using a text alert system to send needed reminders. The text alerts *do not replace calendars.* Follow directions on the calendar to sign up!


Field Trips – Senior Camp takes a variety of field trips. Some will require specific clothing, lunches, and/or different departure or return times. Watch information closely. Trip information is on the calendar, posted at the room, sent via text alerts. Trips are subject to change.

Spending Money – The cost of the field trip for the campers is already in the weekly fee. In most cases, no additional spending money is invited for a trip. If spending money is allowed for the children, it will be denoted by the \$ sign on the calendar. Please do not bring money on other trips.

Chaperones –Any family registered for 2 weeks or more needs to sign up and attend to chaperone a minimum of one trip. The new state regulations for volunteers require that every attending adult that supervises children must have specific background checks. **Attached in this packet are two forms that**

need to be filled out for chaperones and turned in with your registration packet. The forms include one criminal background check as well as one child abuse background check. These forms will be processed with no charge to the parent(s). Those having lived out of PA anytime within the past 10 years are also required to have an additional background check. If this is the case for you, please notify the office so that we can provide you with the necessary form. ****If you already have a completed & processed volunteer criminal background check and a processed volunteer child abuse check from 2015-2016 or from 2016-2017, or from 2017-2018 please attach the 2 copies in lieu of processing new clearances****

We do require that all families sign up for 1 trip at your own expense. Please see the attached list of trips for which a chaperone is needed.

 New this year: A \$50.00 fee will be assessed for any family that does not attend and chaperone 1 trip. No siblings may attend, as we need the chaperones' full attention on the Senior Camp group. There is a chaperone cost per field trip that will be paid to the office in advance (exact change, or checks to Calvary). Chaperones are asked NOT to buy things (gift shop items, face painting, snacks, etc) for the campers when chaperoning – this creates an unfairness to other groups in the camp. If campers are permitted to bring spending money on a trip, they can use their own money for such items.

*******High need for pool chaperones – please consider one of these if you can *******

Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures – Please be sure that you keep your child close in the parking lot and watch for traffic. Parents must walk their children to and from the camp room daily. It is important to connect with the camp teachers to keep apprised of events and field trips. Please also remember to stop at the sign in book, located outside of the office, to sign in and out on your child's individual page every day.

Times for Camp – You may bring your child any time between 6:30 AM – 6:00 PM. Breakfast is served between 7:15-7:30 (for no additional charge) if your child is present during that time period. Please indicate your approximate daily times on the enclosed policies page. This helps us to plan for staffing. We close at 6:00 PM and all children need to be picked up by 6:00 PM. Please aim to pick up by 5:55pm. We do have a late pick up fee – please read enclosed policies. Watch for specific trip information, but plan to have your child here by 8:45 AM daily to avoid missing trips. We will be leaving promptly at 9:00 the majority of trip days ~ plan also to not pick up your child until after 4:30 PM on trip days. *We cannot bring a child back early from a trip or hold the departure of a trip for someone who is late – please consider this when making appointments and committing to other activities.* Some trips require leaving earlier than 9:00 and coming back later than 4:30 so watch the trip information closely. Thank you for your understanding.

Days for Camp – You may sign up for any days – either full week (Monday through Friday), or part week. Indicate which you are signing up for on the enclosed contract. Your child may only attend on the days he/she is contracted for.

Water Activity Days Campers come to camp with bathing suits already on, with clothes on top and sunscreen already applied. They may wear water shoes to play outside in. No flip flops, open backed shoes, or bare feet allowed in the building/playground.

Clothing - Campers must wear modest attire including the bathing suits that will be worn during water activities. No bikini bathing suits can be worn by girls, but tankinis are acceptable. Please additionally be sensitive to the print on clothing. No writing on the backs of bottoms is acceptable. Please also refrain from any clothing with writing that would compromise the Word of God. Short shorts, low cut shirts, and spaghetti straps (alone) are also prohibited from being worn at camp. ******* Please pay attention to the calendar ~ you will notice a Tshirt icon on trip days.** Each camper must wear their camp T-shirt that day. T-Shirts are not to be cut, tied, or altered in any way.

Weeks for Camp – Camp runs from June 17th to August 16th. Indicate on the enclosed contract which weeks you will be signing up for ahead of time. Whatever weeks you contract for are the ones you must

pay for, regardless of actual attendance. Space for full summer positions (ALL weeks of camp) are given priority over part summer positions. However, regardless of the weeks that you choose, you are guaranteed only the weeks that are contracted for. No contract changes will be accepted after May 30th

Costs for Camp –The first tuition payment is due on the first day of camp ~ Monday, June 17th. The costs are split into a tuition fee and a trip/activity/transportation fee. The trip/activity/transportation fee is based on an average of the total costs for the summer. This trip/activity/transportation fee is not discounted for any reason. Discounts such as sibling, church, etc apply to tuition only. All tuition is rounded to the nearest dollar. If you need us to figure out your payment for you, we'd be happy to do so.

Payments for Camp – Senior Camp payments may be made weekly or monthly – these are the only payments that can be made weekly, due to the nature of the program. Please indicate which method you prefer on the enclosed contract.

- Weekly payments are due each Monday. A late fee of \$10.00 is assessed if payment is not received by 6:00 PM each Tuesday.
- Monthly payments are due on June 17, July 1, and August 1. To determine the monthly payment, take the weekly rate and multiply by the number of MONDAYS. For 2019, June = 2 Mondays. July = 5 Mondays, and August =2 Mondays. A late fee of \$20.00 is assessed if payment is not received by June 19, July 3, and August 2. Online payments are now accepted at www.calvarychristianschool.org

Regardless of the payment method chosen, the first payment is due on the first day of camp – Monday, June 17th. Payments must be made using the payment envelopes, which are located outside of the office. On the payment envelope, designate how much tuition/fees are being paid and be sure to include the child's name. Payment envelopes that are not filled out completely will have payments applied at the discretion of the office staff. Completed payment envelopes are deposited in the mailbox outside of the office.

Emergency Contact Forms – Only people designated on the Emergency Contact Form may pick up your child!! Be sure that we have your most up to date cell number and email address – it is so important that we can always contact you! Be sure that all ALLERGIES are documented here **

Wellness Policy – Our Wellness Policy is attached for you. Please read and follow it closely. Sick children should not be sent to camp. We do not routinely administer Tylenol/Motrin, as it may mask a fever. If your child needs a prescription medicine, please sign it in in the office with complete instructions. If your child is well enough to attend camp, then the assumption is made that they are well enough to participate in all activities.

What to BRING & WEAR Daily



*Labeled lunch with 1 snack (we will provide afternoon snack daily) and plenty of drinks EVERYDAY unless otherwise noted on the calendar – there should be enough in the lunch for a morning snack. Lunches are not refrigerated – so feel free to include an ice pack. Lunches are also not heated. On trip days, a COMPLETELY DISPOSABLE lunch is needed.

*Backpack – labeled with name

*Sunscreen—preferably the spray on kind— labeled with name. Staff cannot apply sunblock to body parts by hand, so please consider purchasing the spray kind of sunblock.

*Bible-(NLT preferred) - labeled with name

*Comfortable clothing that is modest – we do get messy, so wear play clothes (see section about clothing)

*Leave SOCKS in your camp bag daily – bowling is an inclement weather back up plan! 😊

*Extra change of clothing to stay in the backpack (spills and bathroom accidents do happen!)

*Although we still recommend closed toe shoes as the safest footwear, we will allow open toed shoes with backs to be worn at camp. However, **NO FLIP FLOPS** or **backless shoes** may be worn on any days including water play days.



What **NOT** to bring daily:

- *any electronics – video games, iPods, video watches, cell phones, etc
- *toys from home – including Bayblades, craft looms, playing cards, etc.
- *NO FLIP FLOPS
- * No backless shoes

Expectations of Senior Campers

Camp is designed to be fun! With all fun experiences, there are guidelines and boundaries that need to be followed. It is our desire to help everyone in Senior Camp to understand that Jesus loves them so much and that we love them too. We strive to balance love and correction throughout the day. We do expect children to participate in summer camp by being respectful to peers and to adults. If a behavior problem prevents a child from being able to attend a trip, we will notify the parents. In some cases, it may be necessary for the child to be picked up. Of course we anticipate no such problems, but we need to let you know of the expectations up front for the good of all.

TRIP PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Calvary Child Care Center will be providing proper supervision and adequate personnel for the planned activities, and is covered by Brotherhood Mutual Insurance Company. However, in the event of bodily or personal injury, except for gross negligence, parents are expected to inform their own personal medical insurance provider. I give my permission for my child to attend the listed field trips and be transported by a rented bus, Calvary Child Care Center mini-van, or Calvary bus. I release Calvary Child Care Center of any and all liability that may arise from the trips (except as noted above - only due to gross negligence). I understand that trips may be changed due to inclement weather or other reasons. I further understand that field trip attendance is contingent upon my child's behavior. I agree to schedule myself or another family adult to chaperone one trip during the summer. I understand that if payments are not made according to the contract agreement stated above my child will no longer be enrolled at Calvary's Summer Camp.

Parent Agreement ~ Policies

1. Calvary Child Care Center is an extension of Calvary Full Gospel Church. As such, Biblical truths and principles will be openly shared with the children on a daily basis. We believe the Bible to be the inspired Word of God, the only rule of faith and practice. It is a divine guide to everyday living, as relevant to our lives today as when God's Word was first written.

We Believe ... We believe that God offers to every person the forgiveness of sins through the sacrifice of His Son. The scriptural plan of salvation is simple and definite:

- a) *All are sinners. Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."*
- b) *Sin must be punished: Romans 6:23a "For the wages of sin is death."*
- c) *God sent His son Jesus Christ to take our punishment for us by dying on the cross: Isaiah 53:5b "...the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him ..."*
- d) *Eternal life is a gift: Ephesians 2:8, 9 "For by grace are you saved through faith, and not of yourselves, it is a gift of God, not of works least any person should boast."*
- e) *Be receiving Christ, we receive eternal life: 1John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all sin."*

2. A 7% discount will be applied to 2 child families. A summer camp child must be contracted for 2 weeks per month in order to qualify for the multiple child discount. If a summer camp child is only contracted for one week in a month, the sibling discount will only be extended to the summer camp child. A 25% discount will be applied to families with twins in the program.

10% discount applied to families in which the parents are faithfully attending and faithfully financially supporting Calvary Full Gospel Church. A 30% discount will be applied to families with 3 or more children enrolled. No other discounts apply to families receiving a 30% discount already. All discounts are contingent upon an account being in good standing. Discounts are made null and void should an account accrue a balance of any size.

A summer camp child must be contracted for at least 2 weeks per month in order for both children to receive the sibling discount. If a summer camp child is only contracted for one week in a month, the sibling discount is only extended to the summer camp child.

3. It is the parents' responsibility to strictly adhere to the Wellness Policy.
4. Calvary will be completely closed on July 4, 2019 – no reduction is given for tuition.
5. The center is scheduled to close at 6:00 PM. A late pick up fee of \$10.00 will be charged to parents when picking up children between 6:06–6:15 PM. Thereafter, a fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each additional 15 minute increment. This fee will be due in a separate check or money order, payable within 3 days. This is assessed regardless of the reason for late pick up.
6. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for a returned check. It is not our policy to accept post-dated checks or cash. In the event a family bounces more than 1 check, the center will require all future payments to be paid with money orders.
 7. Parents are asked to park only in lined spaces in the parking lot. Handicapped spots are primarily for those with the applicable signage. At no time should any vehicles be parked along the curb – this is dangerous to your vehicle, other vehicles, and children exiting the building.
 8. Parents must walk their children to and from the classrooms and sign in and out daily. Do not drop off campers at the door.

The new state regulations require that every attending adult that supervises children directly must have specific background checks. All chaperoning parents must complete the TWO background check applications (see attached). If you have completed volunteer clearances from 2015-2016, or newer, please attach them to this packet instead. Anyone who has lived out of state within the last 10 years must also have a third background check completed. Please contact the office if you need the third background check.

All chaperones are asked to please arrive about 10 minutes before departure time. Attending chaperones should come prepared on the day of the trip with a disposable lunch – if needed. In addition, chaperones must pay admission costs on the morning of the trip, in cash, directly to the office.

We do require that all families sign up for trips at your own expense.

Families contracted for 2 weeks or more must sign up for 1 field trip per summer to chaperone.
Pool trips are most needed, and are close and cheap!

If you or an adult family member (with processed volunteer clearances) cannot attend any trips then a \$50 fee is required.

Type Yes if able to chaperone with the name of the trip(s) or type No if you are unable to chaperone and will be paying the \$50 non chaperone fee.

Wellness Policy

Calvary Child Care Center/Calvary Christian School is concerned about the health and safety of your child. We will take every measure to insure your child's well being. It is our goal to keep every child safe and healthy. We need your assistance in this effort.

The following guidelines must be strictly followed in an effort to keep all children healthy:

1. *Should your child become ill while at the center, we will phone you at work and expect your child to be picked up as soon as possible. If leaving work for this reason poses a problem, we suggest finding an emergency contact person that will be able to do this for you.*
2. ***Should your child need to visit a doctor due to illness, we will need a **certificate of return from your doctor stating the date when your child can return to the center.**
3. We may administer doctor prescribed medication only. All "over the counter" medication (including Tylenol, Motrin, etc.) will only be administered with a doctor's note dated specifically to the current illness. An exception to this rule may be a child with a pain issue without a suspicion of a contagious illness. The only exception to this policy is for over the counter decongestants or antihistamines, which may be given without a doctor's note. Every other "over the counter" medication must have a doctor's note. Medication is dispensed mid day only (between 11:30 - 2:30).
4. ***Sick children must remain at home until they are well enough to come back to the center/school. When children are present at child care or school, they are deemed well enough to also participate in outdoor activity. Specific amendments to this policy include but are not limited to:
 - a. A child must be **fever free for 24 hours** before they may attend the center
 - b. A child must be **free from vomiting for 24 hours** before they may attend the center
 - c. If a child has diarrhea he/she must **remain at home for 24 hours unless your doctor sees the child** and sends a note dictating otherwise.

Diarrhea is defined by one of the following:

 - 1a. one runny stool accompanied by a fever (101+)
 - 1b. 3 runny stools in succession
 - d. ****A child will need to leave the center and be seen by a physician should any discharge be evident from the eyes. If a contagious eye condition is present, the child must be given a full 24 hours of appropriate medication before returning to the building.**
 - e. ****A child must remain at home until he/she has been on an antibiotic for a full 24 hours or appropriate doses.**
 - f. Any other contagious condition will be dealt with an individual basis.

****Exceptions to this wellness policy will only be made if a doctor's note states otherwise. This must be in writing (with a specific date!!) from your doctor.**
