School Supply List for Middle School

Note: Students should keep a supply all year of these items ~ it's cheaper to buy supplies now and keep them at home as things wear out or get misplaced!

PLEASE BRING ALL ITEMS ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- NIV Bible
- 2 padlocks per student for lockers
 - LOCKER NOTES:
 - Students must have locked lockers.
 - Combinations will be given to homeroom teacher on the first day
 - It's a good idea for new lock users to practice using the lock at home before school starts!
 - Parents may need to replace the lock if student breaks/misplaces it
 - Locker decorations must contain appropriate images only. Nothing will be posted on the outside of the locker unless it is Biblically based. All decorations must be easily removable and not damage the locker.
 - Lockers are the property of the school. No expectation of privacy is implied.
- 2 packages of 3 x 5 index cards
- Flash drive no more than 4 gb needed ~ label with name (a lanyard to hold it is a good idea)
- Scientific calculator (includes functions like pi, square root, etc.)
- Three sturdy small 3 ring binders (1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ ") OR one large zippered binder w/dividers
- 5 packages of loose leaf notebook paper (wide rule)
- 5 pocket folders
- Colored pencils
- 3 glue sticks
- 8 dry erase markers any colors
- 4 packages of pencils (buy extra for home!) mechanical pencils preferred!
- 1 large eraser
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 package of pens
- 5 composition books
- 1 ruler with metric measure
- 2 boxes of soft tissues
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 2 large book covers

Additional items may be needed for special projects. It is wise to purchase more than needed of items such as pencils when they are on sale!

CELL PHONES, if a parent wishes a student to use in transporting to school, must be signed in and out of the office daily.
